Parking in Konstanz

Bike handover

→ Pick-up at Radweg-Reisen in Konstanz between 9 am and 7 pm, 7 days per week. On request delivery to the hotel, then no individual adjustment by our staff on site. Departure: Return at Radweg-Reisen or guests leave them at the hotel.

Luggage transport

→ Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- → 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Constance

Take the opportunity to visit the island of Mainau, wander through Constance's old town or visit the aquariums in the Sea Life Center and go to the Archaeological Museum.

Day 2: Constance – Kressbronn, approx. 35 km + ferry ride

The car ferry takes you from Constance to Meersburg and cycling through vineyards you reach the Zeppelin town of Friedrichshafen. In Friedrichshafen we can recommend a visit to the Zeppelin museum. You continue on through extensive orchards to today's destination of Kressbronn.

Day 3: Wellness, swimming and sailing

Take it easy with a spa treatment in the hotel, down at the lakeside beach or go exploring the town centre. In the evening an experienced skipper takes you out sailing for a couple of hours on the lake. You can also look forward to the three course dinner, which is included at the day of your sailing trip!

Day 4: Day trip to Bregenz, approx. 50 km

Your first stop is the Bavarian town of Lindau, where you shouldn't forget to explore the old town, which lies entirely on an island. The harbour, watched over by a 6-metre high lion, is a lovely place to sit and watch the boats. Now it's just a few kilometres to Bregenz, the capital town of the Vorarlberg region of Austria and famous for its annual festival on the world's largest lake-stage. We can recommend a trip by cable car up the Pfänder where you have wonderful views of the lake.

Day 5: Kressbronn – Constance, approx. 35 km + ferry ride

Cycle at a leisurely pace along the banks of the lake back to Friedrichshafen where the car ferry takes you back to the other side of the lake to Romanshorn. The path is almost always along the side of the lake as you pedal back to Constance and takes you past lovely beaches perfect for a refreshing dip.

Day 6: Excursion to Überlingen, approx. 35 km + boat and ferry trip + canoe rental

From Constance, you cycle along the lakeside, past the flower island of Mainau to Wallhausen, where you pick up your canoe. Now you explore Lake Constance's beautiful sights from the water for the next three hours. You can decide for yourself where you want to go. But be sure to paddle to the Marienschlucht canyon and the "Teufelstisch" ("Devil's table"), an impressive under water rock formation. After returning your canoe, you go from Wallhausen by a bigger boat to Überlingen on the other side of the lake. A great cycling trip awaits you: Riding past Wallfahrtskirche Birnau through Uhldingen you finally reach the medieval town of Meersburg. From the harbour you take the car ferry back to Constance.

Day 7: Excursion to Reichenau Island & Stein, approx. 50 km + boat trip

Your first destination is Reichenau Island, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2001. A boat takes you to the Höri peninsula to Gaienhofen, where you can visit the Hermann Hesse House. You then cycle further along the Höri peninsula via Hemmenhofen, where Otto Dix lived for a time, to Stein am Rhein. The return journey takes you through small Swiss fishing villages back to Constance.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
