Your tour

The Werra rises in the Thuringian Forest near the Rennsteig and meanders through the Thuringian-Hessian border region until it joins the Fulda in Hann. Münden in Lower Saxony. Disappeared for decades in the zonal border or restricted area, many natural and cultural monuments await discovery on the Werra cycle path. Cycle leisurely through the Green Heart of Germany. On your way, you will visit charming villages with beautiful old towns and small industrial towns with an eventful history before the Werra and Fulda join to form the Weser. According to legend, Alexander von Humboldt proclaimed Hann. Münden to be one of the "seven most beautiful towns in the world"!

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Meiningen

The city can look back on a shining past as royal seat of the Ernestine dukes. Buildings such as the castle and the theatre testify to these times. Railway enthusiasts may also be familiar with Meiningen – the local depot is the only European company specialized in the maintenance of steam locomotives for clubs and museums.

Day 2: Meiningen - Bad Salzungen, approx. 45 km

Today you will reach Bad Salzungen, which is located between the south-west slope of the Thuringian forest and the northern slope of the anterior Rhön. Enjoy a stroll through the historical town centre, but allow for enough time for a visit to the Celtic Spa. Along with the graduation houses, it is the oldest spa in Germany; it attracts visitors with its treatment and wellness services, but also offers a modern swimming and sauna complex.

Day 3: Bad Salzungen - Dankmarshausen, approx. 40 km

Soon after you start cycling you should get off your bicycle again — the adventure mine Merkers wants to take you on an underground adventure. In Philippsthal there is a museum informing visitors about the former German-German border, and near Heringen the Monte Kali, an enormous spoil tip, attracts attention.

Day 4: Dankmarshausen - Eisenach, approx. 40 km

Soon after you start cycling you should get off your bicycle again — the adventure mine Merkers wants to take you on an underground adventure. In Philippsthal there is a museum informing visitors about the former German-German border, and near Heringen the Monte Kali, an enormous spoil tip, attracts attention.

Day 5: Eisenach - Eschwege, approx. 60 km

You will cycle to Creuzburg, with its lovely castle buildings and a truly ancient stone bridge. Proceed to Treffurt, with its vast variety of old timbered houses and the town of Wanfried, which was once the final destination of the Weser / Werra shipping. Your aim for today will be Eschwege, which was impressively rebuilt by Hapsburg Croats after being completely destroyed in the 30 Year War.

Day 6: Eschwege - Hann. Münden, approx. 60 km

Today is first stop is in Bad Sooden, an old spa and saline town. Here you will also find an old graduation house and a salt-inhalatorium. The tour will take you further to the beautiful cherry town of Witzenhausen, where you will find such astounding establishments as the institute for tropical agriculture. After a brief strengthening (not included) in the local inn, the Letzter Heller, you will be cycling to Hann. Münden. Let the day come to a close on a stroll through the atmospheric historical town centre and the old harbour.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
