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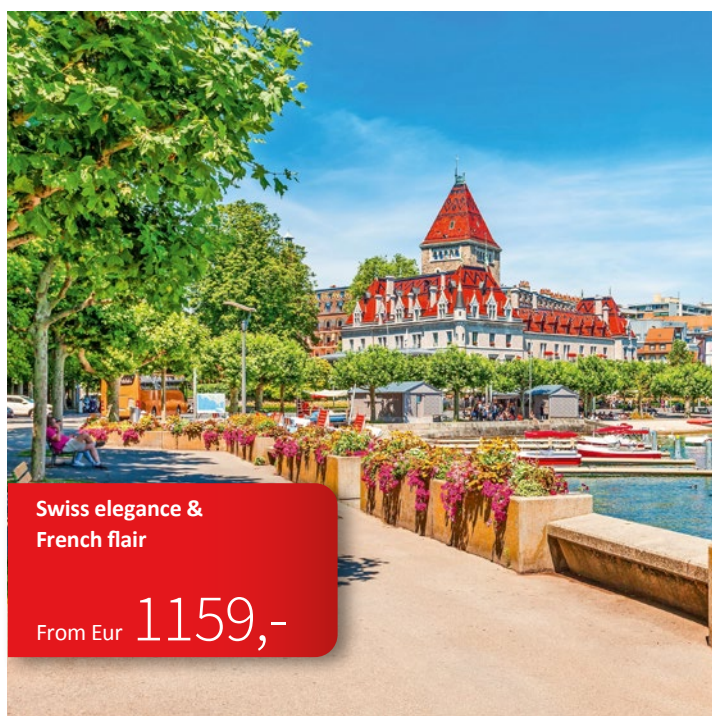

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Lausanne

Welcome to Lausanne, the elegant city on the northern shore of Lake Geneva. Switzerland's Olympic capital impresses with its charming old town, magnificent views of the Alps and a lively lakeside promenade in Ouchy. Take the opportunity to visit the Olympic Museum or stroll through the cobbled streets of the old town. In the evening, Lausanne is the perfect place to start your journey - whether in one of the traditional restaurants or in a modern bistro with a view of the lake.

Day 2: Lausanne – Yvoire, approx. 30 km + boat trip

Boat trip to Évian-les-Bains in the morning. The journey on the French side of Lake Geneva brings with it a little-known change of perspective. Now the hills of the Jura chain greet you from the other side of the lake. There are countless bathing opportunities on the shores of the Haute-Savoie. Today's destination is the medieval town of Yvoire.

Day 3: Yvoire – Geneva, approx. 25 km

Picturesque harbours and charming villages await you on the journey to the Swiss border. Shortly after crossing the border you pass the village of Hermance. In Cognay you see the jet for the first time d'Eau, which will take you to Geneva.

Day 4: Geneva – Nyon / Prangins, approx. 45 km

You quickly leave the hustle and bustle of the city behind you and are soon travelling along the Jura chain high above the shores of Lake Geneva. There is little traffic on the side roads and wonderful views of the lake and the peaks of the Mont Blanc massif open up before you. You will spend the night either in Nyon or in the neighbouring village of Prangins. Castles worth seeing await you in both stage towns.

Day 5: Nyon – Lausanne, approx. 45 km

Today you stay on the shores of Lake Geneva. Stately estates and well-tended beaches characterise the day. In the second part of the day, the route climbs gently and leads into the vineyards. You pass the

market town of Morges and shortly afterwards reach the promenade of Lausanne. The city is home to the Olympic Committee and has a large number of well-developed sports facilities and a museum on Olympic history that is well worth a visit.

Day 6: Lausanne – Montreux, approx. 35 km

A highlight awaits you at the end of the tour. Traditional dry stone walls, countless wine cellars and a fantastic view make the ride through the vineyards of Lavaux one of the most beautiful cycle tours you can

take in Switzerland. The tour then continues along the shores of Lake Geneva via Vevey to Montreux. If you wish, you can continue the tour to Chillon Castle.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
