Your tour

The Rhône Route in Switzerland is a wonderful destination for all those who can't get enough of the Alps in Switzerland, but don't want to climb the mountains on a bike. Across the sun-drenched Goms Valley in the canton of Valais, your cycle route of the National Cycle Route No. 1 runs on relatively flat paths. Great views of the mountain panorama are guaranteed! The brown wooden houses of the Welsh villages or the old town of Brig with its patrician houses are striking. One of the most beautiful views finally awaits you on your final stage: you cycle along Lake Geneva with its glittering waves, behind which the impressive Mont Blanc massif rises. Your cycle tour along Switzerland's Rhône route ends in cosmopolitan Geneva.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Oberwald (cat B) / Obergesteln (cat A)

When you arrive in Oberwald or Obergesteln, you first look out over the Goms Valley. Both possible overnight stops are typical mountain villages with old, sun-browned wooden houses. The Valais mountain scenery is the perfect introduction to the Rhône route in Switzerland.

Day 2: Oberwald / Obergesteln – Brig, approx. 45 – 50 km

You cycle through the open valley with a view of the fascinating mountain panorama. The Rhône meanders its way here. You cycle downstream. Despite everything, you still have to tackle a few climbs to Brig. In the capital of Upper Valais at the foot of the Simplon Pass, you will immediately notice the baroque Stockalper Palace from the 17th century. In the nearby interactive World Nature Forum, you can experience the world of the Alps in a sensory way.

Day 3: Brig – Sierre, approx. 45 km

Cycle along the Rhône, which is still wild at first, on flat cycle paths following the Rhône Route No. 1 signs through the ever-widening Valais valley. The charming villages contrast with the mountains, which are up to 4000 metres high. Between Leuk and Sierre, you leave the Rhône Route and cycle through marvellous vineyards to a winery. You can sample the quality of the wines at a wine tasting. Incidentally, French is spoken from here onwards. You will spend the night in the town of Sierre.

Day 4: Sierre – Martigny, approx. 45 km

Cycle through lush green vineyards and extensive fruit and vegetable fields to Martigny. Numerous sights bear witness to the town's rich history. Stroll through the history of the Celts, Romans and Napoleon's

troops, who left their mark here. Martigny is famous for its castle ruins of La Bâtiaz. Martigny impresses with its southern flair, tasty cuisine and historical heritage.

Day 5: Martigny – Montreux (Cat B) / Vevey (Cat A), approx. 50 / 60 km

You cycle through a landscape that opens up. High mountains and lowlands alternate here on the Rhône route. On Lake Geneva, in a sheltered bay surrounded by vineyards, lies the town of Montreux. The snow-capped Alps offer a breathtaking view. Passing the moated castle of Chillon via Montreux, you reach Vervey. The location directly on the lake with a view of the Alpine panorama will enchant you.

Day 6: Montreux – Prangins / Nyon, approx. 65 – 70 km

In the morning you cycle on via Lausanne. Switzerland's Olympic city with its Gothic cathedral lies before you, modern and multifaceted. Enjoy its unique location on Lake Geneva. With the Mont Blanc massif

firmly in view, cycle along the lake to Morges. Visit Morges Castle with its four museums or take a stroll along the lakeside promenade. From July to October, 1.5 kilometres of the lakeside road are adorned with dahlias.

Day 7: Nyon – Geneva, approx. 60 / 30 km

After breakfast, you cycle along the lake to Geneva. The villas and yachts get bigger the closer you get to Geneva. The French-speaking city is nestled between Alpine peaks in the bay where the Rhone leaves Lake Geneva. In the lively old town streets of fashionable Geneva, you will come across a multitude of elegant boutiques. The lakeside promenades with their unique view of the dreamlike lake with its 140-metre-high water fountain are worthwhile in a different way.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
