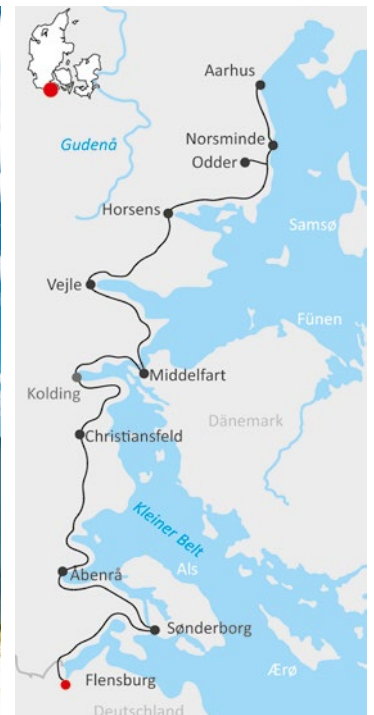

From Flensburg, your journey leads you to Aarhus, the second biggest city of Denmark. In the middle of this, you cycle to old port cities, villages, that are full of history, attractive landscapes, that are full of dense forests and meadows. Thereby, the Baltic Sea is never far and provides with its mild climate and fine sand beaches refreshing and sun-spoilt moments. Let's go!

Parking in Flensburg

- Parking garages in the center, e.g. Parkhaus City, Süderhofenden 4 - 6, costs approx. 14 Euro / day
- Hotel parking (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents)

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Flensburg

Flensburg is located to the north of Germany and is therefore an ideal starting point for a cycling tour on the Baltic Sea Cycle Route. After your arrival, stroll through the beautiful alleys and corners of the old town with its typical Flensburg merchants' courtyards.

Day 2: Flensburg – Sønderborg, approx. 45 km

Today you first cycle along the Flensburg Fjord. On the way it is worth stopping for a visit at the summer residence of the Danish royal family in Gråsten. Sønderborg, your first destination, is on the island of Als. Visit the Sønderborg Slot. The castle of the 12th century now houses a museum.

Day 3: Sønderborg – Åbenrå, approx. 35 km

Today's route is relaxed and takes you through forests and wide fields over the Sundewitt peninsula. A visit to Sandbjerg Castle, one of the most elegant palaces in Southern Jutland, is worthwhile. Åbenrå captivates with its charming town houses and craftsmen's houses.

Day 4: Åbenrå – Christiansfeld, approx. 40 / 70 km

Today you cycle first to Haderslev. The medieval old town on Haderslev Dam has many cafés and a walk along the medieval reservoir. Back on the saddle, you cycle comfortably through the quiet area to Christiansfeld.

Day 5: Christiansfeld – Middelfart, approx. 45 / 65 km

After leaving Christiansfeld, you cycle through the wooded region to Kolding. From afar you can already see the massive tower of the old royal castle Koldinghus. Passing Kolding Fjord and via Skærbæk, you cross the Little Belt just before you reach your destination for the day, Middelfart.

Day 6: Middelfart – Vejle, approx. 55 km

The city of Fredericia lies on the other side of Middelfart and can be reached by crossing the Little Belt. Worth seeing is the center of the city, which was created in a checkerboard pattern. Once in Vejle a visit to the windmill, the symbol of the city, is worthwhile. Inside it contains a museum about the history of the mill.

Day 7: Vejle – Horsens, approx. 45 km

Today's cycle route inland is partly hilly and surrounded by forests. A former state prison can be visited in Horsens. Vitus Bering is the celebrity of this town. In the 18th century he sailed through the Bering Strait, named after him, between America and Asia. Even the city park in Horsens commemorates him.

Day 8: Horsens – Norsminde / Odder, approx. 50 / 60 km

Today you continue north. After countless glances at the glittering Baltic Sea and with one or the other fresh sea breeze you reach your overnight accommodation in Norsminde or Odder. How about an evening stroll through the city?

Day 9: Norsminde / Odder – Aarhus, approx. 30 / 20 km

Today's bike route is short on purpose. Like this you can enjoy Aarhus, the second largest City of Denmark, a bit longer. On the way there you find numerous opportunities for a longer break on the beach.

Day 10: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
