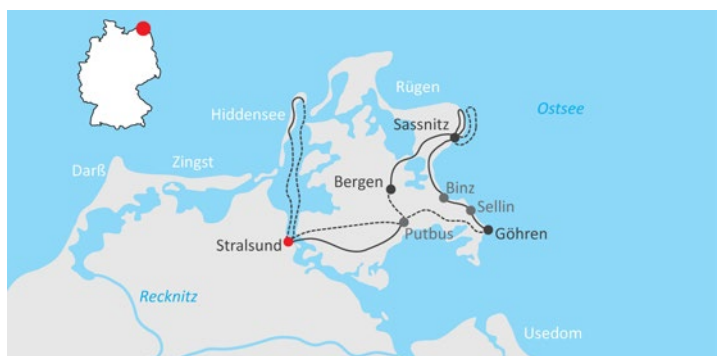

- Closest airports: Hamburg, Berlin, Rostock-Laage, Heringsdorf
- Train station: Stralsund

Parking in Stralsund

- Public car park at the Meeresmuseum (280 spaces), costs approx. 28 EUR for 2 days and 8 EUR for each additional day.
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Stralsund

The starting point of your cycle tour is the old Hanseatic town Stralsund, whose old town was declared a UNESCO World Heritage site because it has been so beautifully preserved. Its former importance as a trading town can still be seen today. Let your evening come to a pleasant end in the old town and wander across the harbour island, where the old sailing-school ship, the Gorch Fock can be visited.

Day 2: Excursion to Hiddensee island

In the morning, take the ship to the island of Hiddensee, where you can cycle to the 28 m high lighthouse „Leuchfeuer Dornbusch“, or spend a day swimming on the beach, or take a horse-drawn carriage ride... You are spoilt for choice. In the afternoon, take the boat back to Stralsund.

Day 3: Stralsund – Sassnitz, approx. 25 km + train ride

Today you first travel by train to the centre of the island, to the largest city on Rügen: Bergen. Here it is worth visiting the Rugard, Bergen's highest point at 91 metres above sea level. The route then takes you past the Nonnensee, an ice-age meltwater lake, which you can walk round on a circular route and observe many birds. You follow the cycle path between the Small and Great Jasmund Bodden to Sassnitz.

Day 4: Excursion to the chalk cliffs, approx. 20 km or boat trip

With its 500 hectares of beech forest, moors, meadows and tranquil lakes, Jasmund National Park is a natural paradise par excellence. The landmarks of Rügen are the chalk cliffs with the 118-metre-high Königsstuhl. The cycle tour to the chalk cliffs is short but strenuous. If you feel like taking it easy, you can choose the sea route to the chalk cliffs (boat trip not included). An old wooden staircase with 412 steps leads from the beach to the plateau.

Day 5: Sassnitz – Sellin / Göhren, approx. 30 / 35 km

After leaving Sassnitz behind, you will reach the impressive buildings of Prora after a few kilometres on today's stage of your cycling holiday on Hiddensee, Rügen and Usedom. Only a few kilometres away, Binz, the largest seaside resort on Rügen, awaits you. From Binz you first cycle a little away from the Baltic Sea and have the opportunity to make a detour to the Granitz hunting lodge. The pier in Sellin, almost 400 metres long, is another highlight of today's stage. A few kilometres away you reach Göhren on the Mönchgut peninsula.

Day 6: Day on the beach or hiking on the Mönchgut peninsula

Mönchgut peninsula is surrounded by the Baltic Sea on three sides and is one of Rügen's wonderful secrets. The diverse countryside has a lot to offer. You can decide spontaneously what you feel like doing: a relaxed day swimming at the beach or a short walk through the dunes, over the heaths into the woods. No matter how you decide, you're sure to like it!

Day 7: Göhren – Stralsund, approx. 50 km + train ride

From Göhren, take the Raging Roland (included) to Putbus. The foundation stone for the steam-powered railway was laid at the end of the 19th century. Since then, it has connected the Baltic seaside resorts with Putbus, the youngest town on Rügen. Putbus, known as the White Town, was once laid out as a planned town in the classicist style. Cycle through the south of Rügen towards Stralsund. Once you have crossed the Rügen dam, you are already at your destination.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
