Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Munich

Welcome to the white-blue metropolis of Munich. If you have booked rental bikes, they will be waiting for you at your hotel. Take some time to explore this royal city. Munich was founded as early as the 12th century. With all of the sights this city has to offer, you'll definitely find your own personal highlight among them. Munich Hofbräuhaus is known the world over for its traditional beer. Are you more interested in culture? Then you'll love the internationally known museums, galleries or theatres.

Day 2: Munich - Starnberger See, approx. 45 - 60 km

The first stage of your cycle tour takes you through Forstenrieder Park to the famous Lake Starnberg. Quaint villages, villas and small castles line the shores of the picturesque lake. Upper Bavaria looks like something out of a picture book here! And if you need to cool off, just jump into the crystal-clear water at one of the many bathing spots.

Day 3: Starnberger See - Murnau am Staffelsee, approx. 30 km

Passing the Riegsee lake, you reach Murnau and the Murnauer Moos, a huge, unspoilt moor. Due to the large number of watercourses and lakes, an unrivalled wealth of species has been preserved here, which is particularly effective against the majestic Alpine panorama.

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Expressionists such as Kandinsky were already inspired by this impressively beautiful landscape. They called the region the Blue Land. In Murnau, you can get closer to the artists' works in one of the museums.

Day 4: Murnau - Garmisch-Partenkirchen, approx. 40 km

You first cycle through the Murnauer Moos, a huge, unspoilt moor. Thanks to its diverse ecosystems and the large number of watercourses and lakes, an unrivalled wealth of species has been preserved here. You then reach your destination for the day, Garmisch-Partenkirchen. The town developed from a post station on the Via Claudia to become the venue for the Olympic Games and World Ski Championships.

Day 5: Stay in Garmisch-Partenkirchen

You can organise today as you wish. There is more than enough to discover in and around Garmisch-Partenkirchen. For all those who want to go up high, a trip to the Zugspitze is a good idea. The Zugspitze cable car takes you up Germany's highest mountain in comfort (not included)

Day 6: Garmisch-Partenkirchen - Wallgau, approx. 20 - 70 km

Cycle from Garmisch-Partenkirchen via Klais to the beautiful Barmsee lake. You then have the option of cycling directly to your overnight accommodation or taking a detour via Mittenwald and Scharnitz to the source of the Isar. A total of 300 meters in altitude are covered to Scharnitz, from there slightly uphill through wild and romantic gorges and lush alpine meadows to the source of the Isar. Return through the sunny high valley with magnificent panoramic views of the Karwendel and Wetterstein mountains via Mittenwald to Wallgau - a place where Bavarian traditions are still alive and well.

Day 7: Wallgau - Bad Tölz, approx. 50 km

Cycle through the Isarwinkel to Sylvensteinsee, a fjord-like reservoir with an imposing bridge that often serves as a photo opportunity. Bad Tölz, the famous moor and brine spa, pampers the senses with its colourful facade paintings. The centrepiece is the spacious spa park, where you can stretch your cycling legs. One of the most famous guests who enjoyed spending the summer in Bad Tölz was Thomas

Day 8: Excursion to Tegernsee, approx. 45 km

Cycle through the charming Tegernsee countryside to Gmund. Enjoy the marvellous panorama in this tradition-conscious town and make sure you plan time for a boat trip. Lake Tegernsee is one of the cleanest lakes in Bavaria. Cycle back to Bad Tölz through the Gaißbach valley. If you don't fancy cycling, you can also make the trip by train or relax in the thermal waters of the Alpamare spa.

Day 9: Bad Tölz - Munich, approx. 60 km

The Isar river leads you out of Bad Tölz today. Following the Isar cycle path, you pedal through green landscape to Wolfratshausen. The historic rafter town is situated idyllically between Isar and Loisach. Enjoy the tranquility this cycling holiday offers, along the river. Maybe spend some time watching the rafters. Today's route has a number of hills to tackle. But the Bavarian capital is not long in coming now. The lively city of Munich is expecting you! Reward yourself in the English Garden, in one of the beer gardens, with a sausage and be inspired by the Bavarian capital's Marienplatz.

Day 10: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.

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
