The well-signposted cycle paths make cycling a pure pleasure. Along the way there are many opportunities to drink a Bavarian beer and enjoy the glittering, snow-covered Alpine panorama. Since this cycling holiday is a star tour, the starting point for all these experiences is always the same. You can comfortably do without packing your suitcase every day.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival at Pelham am See

Once you have arrived at the hotel, you are invited to welcome meeting to provide you with some information. If you have booked rental bikes, they will be ready for you at the hotel. Pelham is in the countryside and not right on Lake Chiemsee. Enjoy Pelham's peace and quiet, or go on a small trip to Prien - the biggest town on Lake Chiemsee. Prien is a historic market community. Today you will love it for its pretty lakeside promenade and restaurants.

Day 2: Excursion to the Eggstätter Seenplatten, approx. 40 / 60 km

Your first cycle on this cycling holiday on Lake Chiemsee takes you through Bavaria's oldest nature reserve. Eggstätter Lake District is made up of a total of 17 lakes. This relaxed tour shows you nature's beauty in its entirety! You pedal past romantic, flower-garlanded farmhouses to reach the tranquil village of Höslwang. Enjoy the wonderful views of the Alpine panorama. Car lovers will love the Museum of German Automotive History in Amerang. A trip to Amerang extends the route by about 20 km.

Day 3: Excursion around Lake Chiemsee, approx. 65 km

On the saddle, get set, go! Once around Lake Chiemsee - that's how your cycle tour begins. On this circular tour, you will discover everything that Bavaria's largest lake has to offer. Lively lakeside towns and picturesque little villages lie along the way. You will find numerous

secluded bays for a break. As you cycle leisurely along the shore, there are always marvellous views of the surrounding mountains. How about a refreshment stop in a shady beer garden?

Day 4: Excursion to the Gentlemen's and Women's Islands, approx. 20 km + boat trip

You cycle a short while to the jetty to Prien. From here, a boat takes you to Herreinsel - the largest island of Lake Chiemsee: this is where the fairy-tale king, Ludwig II, had a replica of Versailles built. Some five kilograms of gold leaf were used in the castle. The bedroom is one of the most sumptuous rooms of the 19th century. When you've finished walking round Herreninsel, you naturally have to go to Fraueninsel: the island and fishing village and the ancient monastery exude a wonderful peace and calm. Immerse yourself in this long lost time. And don't forget to enjoy the local dishes served here.

Day 5: Excursion to Lake Simsee and Rosenheim, approx. 40 km + train ride

Lake Simsee will inspire you with its almost entirely unspoiled reedbanks. Through a nature reserve, you cycle to the River Inn, a well-known tributary to the Danube, and follow the river to Rosenheim. This typically Bavarian town can be seen from afar- identified by its onion domes. Southern flair and Alpine charm are the characteristics of this town. Get off your bike for a change, and explore the pretty old

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quarter of Rosenheim by foot. Even though Rosenheim is not on the lake, a visit to this town on your cycling holiday on Lake Chiemsee is a must. The train (not included) takes you back to Pelham.

Day 6: Excursion to Seeon Monastery, approx. 45 km

You cycle through green countryside and fairy-tale forests to Seeon. In Seeon, the monastery of the same name awaits you. The former Imperial Monastery is situated on an island - and right in the middle of a nature reserve. The monastery was built in 994! It has changed its "service" several times: the high nobility and ducal families used it to reside in; it has also been used as a spa resort. The walk over the

bridge, which connects the island with the mainland, takes you back into a different time. Enjoy the peaceful countryside with a glass of the local wine. On your way back you will be able to spy the dark blue water of Lake Chiemsee. Did you see the small vineyards in the slopes? You now return to your hotel, passing through traditional Bavarian villages.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.

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
