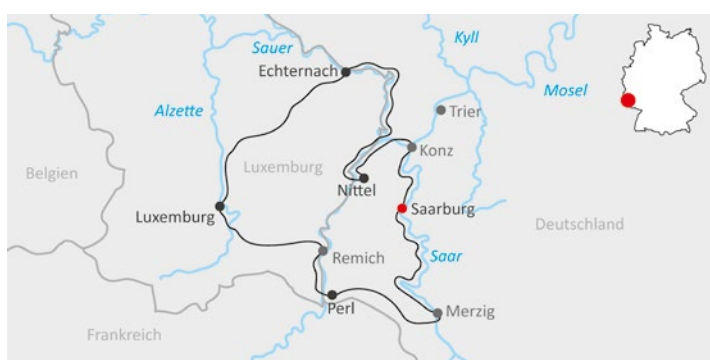

Your tour

On this tour you will travel through the border triangle between Germany, France and Luxembourg. You will get to know the river valleys of the Saar, the Upper Moselle and the Sauer and discover the „Roman Villa Borg“ in Perl, the Saarburg stronghold, the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg and the historic old town of Echternach along the way. In Nittel, taste a typical Elbling wine and learn more about the wine culture on the Moselle, which dates back to Roman times, on the wine trail.

Parking in Saarburg

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Saarburg

Your cycling holiday in Luxembourg begins in Saarburg. The wine town on the Saar impresses with its old town, which is characterized by a 20 meter high waterfall. Already audible from afar, it was created in the Middle Ages to use water power to drive mill wheels. The ruins of Saarburg Castle tower high above the town. It is one of the oldest hilltop castles in southwestern Germany. Taste a Saar wine, which will put you in the right mood for the coming days.

Day 2: Saarburg – Perl, approx. 60 km

The first kilometers of today's stage lead you through the valley of the Saar. With the Saar Loop near Mettlach you will reach one of the most famous sights of the Saarland. From the viewpoint Cloef you have probably the best view - the climb is worth it! The tour continues to Merzig. Here you say goodbye to the Saar and follow the Steinen an der

Grenze, a sculpture road along the border to France, which shows you the way to Perl. With Perl you reach the only wine-growing community of the Saarland.

Day 3: Perl – Luxembourg, approx. 45 km

First you follow the Moselle, which forms the national border between Germany and Luxembourg on the section up to Remich. Remich is considered the center of Luxembourg's winegrowing and has an old town worth seeing. Equally worth seeing is your destination for the day, the capital of Luxembourg. Whether the Grand Ducal Palace, the Bock Casemates or the modern Philharmonic Hall - the image of the city is characterized by a mix of historic and contemporary buildings and knows how to surprise with picturesque corners and exciting places.

Day 4: Luxemburg – Echternach, approx. 50 km

Today, on your cycling vacation in Luxembourg, you will cycle along the so-called Echternach cycle path. After you leave the city of Luxembourg, the landscape changes. Dense forests and impressive rock formations line your bike path, which has some inclines. With Echternach you reach the oldest city of Luxembourg. Enjoy the medieval flair of the town situated in the middle of the Little Luxembourg Switzerland. Take a walk that will lead you through winding alleys and past the remains and towers of the old city wall.

Day 5: Echternach – Nittel, approx. 50 km

On the Sauertal cycle path, you first follow the Sauer River along the German-Luxembourg border. In Wasserbillig you will meet the Moselle. You follow it on the Luxembourg side and reach Wormeldange. Taste a sparkling Riesling from the Wormeldinger Koeppchen vineyard before cycling to your destination for the day, Nittel. Situated between dolomite and limestone rocks, the village is characterized by the cultivation of the Elbling. The Romans already appreciated the taste of this white wine, which is one of the oldest varieties in the world.

Day 6: Nittel – Saarburg, approx. 30 km

With the vineyards along the Moselle in view, follow its course to Konz. The town at the confluence of the Moselle and Saar rivers is ideal for a stopover. Visit the Roscheider Hof. The open-air museum provides insights into the cultural history of both rivers. The tour continues along the Saar. A detour is worthwhile to Tawern a few kilometers away from the river. The name of the village indicates that Tawern once served as a Roman rest stop. On the Metzenberg (attention: steep ascent!) a Roman temple district was built, which can be visited for free. Back on the Saar, you will return to your starting point in Saarburg.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
